Fundraising Goals

We're an independent charity, and only recieve 16% statutory funding from the Government. This means we need to raise £15,000 per day to continue providing care to families across North Hampshire. We can only do this with the support of our amazing community.

Here are some fundraising goals to help your pupils see how they can make a big difference:

£26.35

could help fund the cost of a patient's meals, drinks and snacks for one day.

£36.42

could help fund one of our bereavement sessions for family members.

£99.30

could help fund five hours of nursing care for patients in our care.
