# Memory Tree

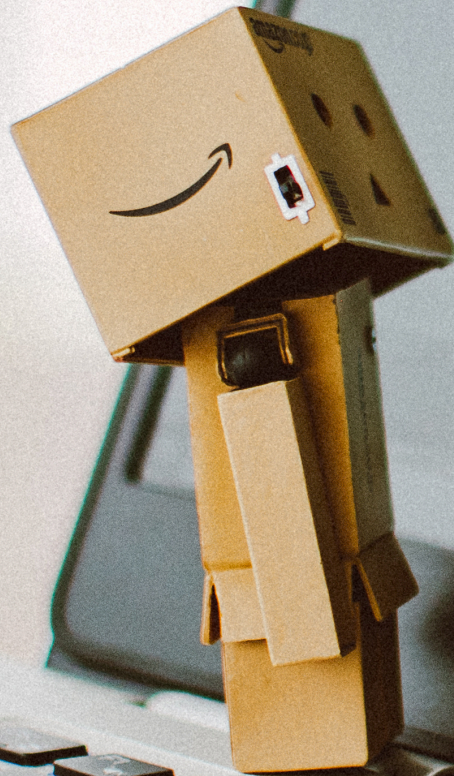
A lasting legacy of love and memories
